CHOICE is designed to prepare students for the future through relevant and rigorous 21st-century curriculum as they work towards earning a high school diploma. CHOICE provides a safe, supportive educational environment for each student. We will help all students achieve personal and academic success so they can transition to higher education or the workplace, and become informed. productive citizens.

CHOICE is an accredited high school and the students earn a high school diploma that meets all of the Washington State and Shelton School District requiements for graduation. CHOICE students will graduate prepared to attend college or pursue their career path. CHOICE serves about 150 students, grades 7-12, who need a flexible schedule (10 hrs/week - full time) based on their learning needs.

CHOICE will provide students with a variety of ways to learn. Each student, guardian, and advisor will work together to develop a individualized learning plan designed to help the student achieve their goals. Students will be able to choose from dynamic classroom experiences, hands-on-learning, CTE classes, and internet-based courses. This program encourages students to become active members of the community through service projects, job shadows, and internships.

CHOICE appeals to students who want to have a voice in the design of their education and who desire flexibility in their schedule/curriculum. Students at CHOICE are able to accelerate their learning retreive credits by completing independetntly paced courses. In addition, our small class sizes provide for extra support for students who need interventions.
